Creating a secure space

Work has started on the installation of two metre high bow top fencing and access points to combat anti-social behaviour and create a secure community space around the high-rise blocks.

The security investment will address concerns about unsecured alleyways, security, anti-social behaviour and drug-taking by providing secure rights of entry to you and your visitors.

Further environmental investment will landscape the secure space within the perimeter fence and create shared communal community gardens.

Each access point will have pedestrian gates next to vehicle access gates. Dedicated fixed cameras will record entrances and exits.
