Prize Draw Rules

1. The Prize Draw is not open to employees or Board Members of Shoreline Housing Partnership
2. The Prize Draw is open to
 - all residents of North East Lincolnshire who have completed a Community Voice form and MUST be over the age of 16
 - spouses, partners and other relatives of employees of Shoreline Housing Partnership, and MUST be over the age of 16

AND

 - have been involved in at least two activities a year with Shoreline Housing Partnership
3. Prizes must be accepted as offered, they will be paid by cheque, and there can be no alternative awards, cash or otherwise.
4. Winners of the prize draw must not be:
 - A tenant in breach of their tenancy agreement for any reason; with the exception of rent arrears when the £100 will be reduced from the outstanding arrears
 - A former tenant who was in breach of their tenancy agreement for any reason; with the exception of rent arrears when the £100 will be reduced from the outstanding arrears
5. The Prize draw will be made three times per year on a regular basis
6. From the Community Voice database, every two involvement activities achieved since the date of the previous draw will entitle a name to be entered once into the draw. (eg. If you are involved in five events since the previous draw then you will have two chances to win)
7. Winners will be chosen at random from all valid entries by a random local resident who may be attending Shoreline House at the time.
8. Winners will be contacted by letter and invited to attend for presentation or when they are available for Shoreline representative to visit them.
9. Shoreline's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
10. Shoreline is compliant with the data protection act. Our policy is such that we will not pass on your details to any third party without your prior consent.
